- 7. No record of conviction of a felony or misdemeanors as identified in the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705 et seq.), or a crime involving moral turpitude; AND
- 8. Must be at least 21 years of age upon employment; AND
- 9. Eligibility for bonding, if required by the employing institution.

<u>NOTE</u>: Persons who have not successfully completed the mandated firearm training course, as approved and recognized by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training & Standards Board, must

complete the course during their probationary period. Police officers are not authorized to carry a service weapon until successfully completing such training.
