### Minimum Qualifications:

1. High School graduation or GED; AND
2. Possession of a valid IL driver's license; AND
3. Be an Illinois resident or agree to become a resident of Illinois within 180 days after the date of his/her appointment; AND
4. Demonstrate at least two (2) years of full-time law enforcement work experience. Required duties assigned must have included: making arrests, enforce laws, investigating crimes, responding to calls for service, using discretion as part of assigned duties, and carrying firearms; AND
5. Have no more than a two (2) year break in service from the time he/she left a comparable law enforcement agency and the time he/she makes his/her application to a state university police department; AND
6. Possess certification from the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board (ILETSB) as a certified full-time police officer, or be eligible to be granted a waiver from ILETSB; AND
7. No record of conviction of a felony or misdemeanors as identified in the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705 et seq.), or a crime involving moral turpitude; AND
8. Must be at least 21 years of age upon employment; AND
9. Eligibility for bonding, if required by the employing institution.

**NOTE:** Persons who have not successfully completed the mandated firearm training course, as approved and recognized by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training & Standards Board, must

complete the course during their probationary period. Police officers are not authorized to carry a service weapon until successfully completing such training.

Desired Qualifications:

- Sensitive to the needs of underrepresented minority populations
- Working knowledge of the behavioral sciences
- Working knowledge of criminal statutes, federal and state, as well as University rules and regulations.
- Working knowledge of criminal justice systems and the criminal courts procedures.
- Working knowledge of University administrative and organizational structures.
- Working knowledge of crime scene searches and the collection, preservation and control of physical evidence.
- Working knowledge of departmental policies and procedures.
- Extensive knowledge of firearms and when to use them in the performance of duty.
- Working knowledge of police communications and procedures.
- Working knowledge of interviewing and interrogation procedures for interviews with victims, witnesses, and suspects.
- Working knowledge of report composition.
- Working knowledge of First Aid.
