**COURSE OVERVIEW:** This fast-paced course is intended for patrol officers and supervisors who want to become more effective in detecting and arresting criminals operating motor vehicles including drug users, drug traffickers, fugitives, and gang members. In addition, the workshop provides the latest intelligence information about the movements and activities of suspected terrorists in the United States. The training focuses on objective criteria for criminal interdiction and not so-called profiling techniques. This program has been approved by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the United States Department of Justice.

**COURSE TOPICS:** Criminal Patrol Procedures, Officer Safety, Current Patterns & Trends, Roadside Interviews, Terrorist Organizations, Resident Aliens & SSN Documents, Detecting Deception, Arrest Tactics, Concealment Areas, Informant Development, International Driving Permit and Criminal Activity & Financing.
