## Modern High Risk Vehicle Traffic Stops

Authority (0.50hrs+0.50scenarios), De-escalation Techniques (0.50hrs+0.50scenarios), High-Risk Traffic Stops(6.00hrs+3.50scenarios), Law Concerning Stops, Searches, and the Use of Force (0.50hrs+0.50scenarios), Officer Safety Techniques, Including Cover, Concealment, and Time (0.50hrs+0.50scenarios)

**COURSE OVERVIEW:** This course will introduce emerging tactics on high-risk vehicle stops, previously referred to as felony vehicle stops. Harnessing modern vehicle design, these tactics will enhance officer safety and emphasize the principles of time, distance, and cover to mitigate risk.

Students will understand and demonstrate a basic understanding of HRVS tactics and the importance of time, distance, and cover.

The scenario-based culminating training event will give students the opportunity to employ these tactics and foster critical thinking skills to safely resolve a multitude of complex problem sets. Instructors and students will debrief after each scenario to evaluate risk mitigation and available courses of action.

## WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU TO CLASS

- 1. Duty Gear & Holster
- 2. Squad Cars are NOT required but Encouraged

**COURSE TOPICS:** Discuss the history, evolution, and lessons learned in past high-risk vehicle stop encounters; Define the overall role, responsibilities, and strategy of contact & cover; Employ the principle of time, distance, and cover to mitigate risk; Recognize the various dynamics of a modern high-risk vehicle stop and demonstrate and employ these principles during scenario-based training.
