**COURSE PURPOSE:** Law Enforcement & School Officials need to obtain the proper information when responding to threats of school violence online. Especially when there is “Leakage” and the posting party is targeting students and school personnel. It is important for the LEO/School Admin to obtain crucial information and evidence in these cases as well as setting into motion due process paperwork in a timely manner. It is then up to the LEO to continue the investigation and use the Exigent Circumstances protocol to get the appropriate information if need be. Identifying the perpetrator immediately gives LE and schools the ability to correct that behavior before the carnage of school shootings ever begin.

**COURSE GOALS:** Obtain the basic overview of various social media networks & what information they possess. \*Learn why it’s important NOT to disregard information that has been given to LEO or schools officials. \*Understanding what the work “leakage” means & how we can interpret the information. \*Understand how to obtain IP’s, screen names, screen captures, email headers, & statements for investigation.
