COURSE DESCRIPTION: 4 hours of training focusing on the modification of Illinois Law concerning the interpretation and application of the principles contained in the Fifth Amendment and Confessions and Admissions Law in Illinois.

- Allow Illinois Law Enforcement Officers and Agencies to become familiar with changes that must be made in their Agency policies as a result of these changes.
