- Describing DWI evidence clearly and convincingly
- Reviewing information regarding recent case law and research studies

CORE TOPICS: Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN), Walk and Turn, and One Leg Stand.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES: Toxicology protocols, processing a DUI arrest, and DUI Report Writing.
