PURPOSE OF THIS COURSE: This program covers Advanced TECC concepts and law enforcement application, as well as Officer-Citizen High Threat Casualty Extraction. Students will learn how to treat the most encountered wound patterns and how to plan and execute an officer or citizen rescue. Scenario-based exercises will allow each student to apply critical lifesaving skills in a dynamic patrol-based setting. Students are required to bring their duty belt/gear and wear clothing appropriate for **physically demanding scenario training**. Students will potentially be exposed to SIMS and simulated blood. If officers or departments have their own SIMS gear, as well as eye/ear pro, they are encouraged to bring it to use. Due to the hands-on nature of this training, course enrollment will be limited to twenty (20) officers.

- Basic Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) Concepts
- Mindset and Situational Awareness
- Mental and Physical Response to Trauma
- Airway Management
- Bleeding and Shock Control
- Rapid Casualty Assessment
- Casualty Extractions and Evacuations
- Treatment and High Threat Extraction Scenarios
