- Cannot have any history of convictions or pleas involving moral turpitude
- Must meet one of the following educational requirements:
 - High School graduate, or
 - Have passed a general education development (GED) test indicating a high school graduation level
- Must not have been discharged from any military service for the following reasons:
 - o Other than honorable conditions,
 - o Bad conduct.
 - o Dishonorable, or
 - Any other characterization of service indicating bad behavior
- Must be capable of performing all essential job functions and work nights, weekends, and holidays
- Must be able to provide credible testimony in a court of law

Pass an oral interview

- Pass an extensive background investigation conducted by the Girard Police Department
