MINIMUM JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a United States Citizen
- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must possess a Part-time or Full-time Police Officer Certification
- Must not be denied a waiver request from the ILETSB
- Must possess, or be able to obtain prior to employment, a valid Illinois Driver's Licenses and have a satisfactory driving record
- Must possess, or be able to obtain prior to employment, a valid Illinois Firearm Owner's Identification (FOID) Card
- Cannot ever have been convicted of any felony offense
- Cannot ever have been convicted of any misdemeanor offense involving domestic battery
- Must be a High School graduate, or have passed a general education development (GED) test indicating a high school graduation level
- Must not have been discharged from any military service for reasons indicating bad behavior
- Must be able to pass a medical examination, polygraph, psychological evaluation, and/or drug screen
- Must be capable of performing all essential job functions and work nights, weekends, and holidays

ALL QUALIFIED APPLICANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- Pass an oral interview
- Pass an extensive background investigation conducted by the Girard Police Department
- Provide proof of highest level of education obtained
- Out of state police officers must pass Firearms Training, Illinois Law for Police Course, and the required equivalency exam.

STARTING PAY:

\$17.50/hour for the first 30 hours/pay period; increasing to \$20.00/hour for any hours over 30 hours /pay period.

ALL OTHER APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS:

- All hired applicants will be required to satisfactorily complete a 12-month probationary period.
- No residency requirement applies.
