## Patrol Carbine/Patrol Rifle Instructor Course

The course culminates with instructor candidates preparing and teaching a half day range as inservice range training format presented to guest student base.

All registrations must go through your Chief, Sherriff, or department training office, even if you are attending class on your own time.
